

MECHANIC

Monona County Secondary Roads Department is looking for a qualified person to fill the vacant position of Mechanic. This position will report to the Road Foreman. The person hired to fill this position will perform skilled and administrative work required to maintain a fleet of vehicles, heavy equipment, and mechanical equipment for the department. This position will also be involved in a variety of tasks associated with roadway maintenance throughout Monona County. This position is an on-call union position.

Qualified applicants should have a high school diploma or GED and a minimum of 3 years of experience maintaining and repairing heavy equipment, shop equipment, and vehicles. Applicants must possess a valid State of Iowa Class B CDL and be able to obtain a Class A CDL within six (6) months of hire.

The successful candidate will have thorough knowledge in these areas:

- Heavy equipment mechanics
- Automotive mechanics
- Gas and diesel engines
- Transmission repair
- Hydraulics and hydraulic systems
- Welding and fabrication
- Equipment parts and purchasing
- Price trends and quality of materials and equipment
- Working knowledge of the hazards and safety precautions common to maintenance and repair activities
- Working knowledge of the practices, methods, materials, and tools used in equipment maintenance
